






MONTESSORI COUNTRY DAY SUMMER PROGRAM 2019

WE ARE EXCITED ABOUT OUR PROGRAM FOR SUMMER CAMP.

Our summer camp activities are created with the Montessori Method in mind, building on the foundation of self-directed curiosity, developed in the traditional Montessori classroom. Our weekly activities will include water play, tending to the garden, music, art, dance, picnics, special guests and our theme-based curriculum involving movement and imagination

TODDLERS

This summer the toddlers will have many exciting themes planned for their age group. Each week we will be exploring a different nature theme with related language and art activities. The summer program will be held in their familiar classroom and will follow the same predictable schedule as they did during the school year with additional water play during their outdoor time. This will allow consistency in routing that toddlers need to feel comfortable, secure and open to learning.

If your child is two-years old by the beginning of summer, he/she may be moving up to the pre-primary classroom this summer, if space permits.

FRIDAY LUNCH AND DESSERT

Dessert Friday occurs each summer camp week with the primary and pre-primary children making dessert. The primary children make dessert for the toddlers. Parents may also choose to buy a pizza lunch on Fridays for their camper. Lunch will include pizza, a side of fruit, veggie and milk or lemonade.
